




Your child will meet a Department for the Economy (DfE) Careers Adviser during Year 12 to discuss the next steps in their career journey.

As a parent/guardian, you play a key role in supporting your child as they explore their future. Here are some ways you can help:

Talk About Their Interests

- . Ask what they enjoyed discussing with the Careers Adviser.
- · Explore what subjects or activities they enjoy most.

Explore Options Together

- . Talk through their next steps. Do they have a back-up plan?
- · Ask them to share the action points they agreed with the Careers Adviser.
- · Attend open days or careers events together.

Encourage Research

Help them use trusted websites.

- . The Careers A-Z list is great for exploring what jobs their subjects might match. Pick at least 3 jobs to explore.
- . Options after Year 12 explains all the options available
- Careers Occupational Information shares informative bulletins and factsheets

Keep Track of Key Dates

- · Note deadlines for applications or open days.
- · Help them stay organised and plan ahead.


Stay Positive and Supportive
