The Board of Governors delegate to the Principal, or his nominee, those functions relating to the admission of pupils.

#### **ADMISSIONS POLICY**

#### ADMISSIONS CRITERIA FOR ENTRY OF PUPILS TO YEAR 8 IN SEPTEMBER 2022

#### Admissions Criteria will be applied in the following order.

- A boy whose brother attends Belfast Boys' Model School.<sup>1</sup>
  (This must be indicated on the Transfer Application noting name of brother).
- A boy whose sister attends Belfast Model School for Girls.<sup>1</sup>
  (This must be indicated on the Transfer Application noting name of sister).
- The first boy in the family to transfer to a secondary (non grammar) school.<sup>1</sup>
  (This must be indicated on the Transfer Application).
- 4 Those applicants for whom Belfast Boys' Model School is the closest controlled school (ie straight line distance from home address to the main entrance of the school in Ballysillan Road). In order to ensure accuracy and impartiality, this information will be provided by the Northern Ireland Ordnance Survey Office.
- 5 In the event of us still not reaching our quota after the application of criteria 1–4, then the final place(s) will be offered to those applicant(s) who live closest to the main entrance to the school (Ballysillan Road). In order to ensure accuracy and impartiality, this information will be provided by the Northern Ireland Ordnance Survey Office.
- 6 In the event of applicants still tying, boys will be selected for admission of the basis of initial letter of surname (as entered on Birth Certificate) in the order set out below:

#### O V P N H Q X R C W G Y B M D S I K J E U T L A F Z

This order was determined by a randomised selection.

In the event of surnames beginning with the same initial letter the subsequent letters of the surname will be used in alphabetical order. In the event of two identical surnames the alphabetical order of the initials of the forenames will be used.

NB All relevant information relating to Criteria 1–6 **MUST** be included on the Transfer Application or else it cannot be taken into consideration.

<sup>1</sup> The definition of 'child of the family' covers those children being cared for in the same household by the same parents/carers. Brother/sister is considered to be a child of the family.

Should family circumstances change after completion of the Transfer Application, it is essential that the parents/guardians inform the Post Primary Admissions Office by 9 March 2022, no later than 4.00 p.m.

## **DUTY TO VERIFY**

The Board of Governors reserves the right to require such supplementary evidence as it may determine to support or verify information on any applicant's Transfer Application/Application Form.

If the requested evidence is not provided to the Board of Governors by the deadline specified, this will result in the withdrawal of an offer of a place. Similarly, if information is supplied which appears to be false or misleading in any material way, the offer of a place will be withdrawn.

## WAITING LIST POLICY

Should a vacancy arise after 21 May 2022, all applications for admission to Year 8 that were initially refused along with new applications and applications where new information has been provided, will be treated equally and the published criteria applied.

This waiting list will be in place until the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022.

If parents/guardians wish to have their son's name remain on the waiting list, beyond this date, they should inform the school in writing. This waiting list will be in place until 30<sup>th</sup> June 2023.

The school will contact you in writing if your son gains a place by this method.

Please contact the school should you wish to have your son's name removed from the list.

# ADMISSIONS CRITERIA – Years 9 – 12 - Criteria will be applied in the following order

- **1** A boy whose brother attends Belfast Boys' Model School.<sup>1</sup>
- **2** A boy whose sister attends Belfast Model School for Girls.<sup>1</sup>
- **3** A boy who is the first child in the family to transfer to a secondary (non grammar) school.<sup>1</sup>
- **4** A boy whose subject choice can be accommodated by Belfast Boys Model School. (This applies to boys applying for places in Years 11-12)
- 5 A boy who has a satisfactory record of attendance (ie over 90% during the previous school year). Mitigating circumstances will be considered in the case of illness, but must be supported by medical evidence. Such mitigating circumstances must be provided in writing.

N.B. All relevant information relating to Criteria 1 - 5 MUST be included on the Application or else it cannot be taken into consideration.
